Urgent Reminder!

An important Message from our Club Secretary

Due to changes in RI regulations, the Club has to pay around 40US\$ fee to RI for every member of the club who is either recorded as a member as of July 1st or as of January 1st. Even if you do not pay the annual dues and decide to terminate your membership, the club still has to pay this fee if you did not inform the club before July 1st/January 1st that you are leaving the club.

In case the club was not informed before these dates, the member has to reimburse the club for these fees. Otherwise a letter of good standing, which is the prerequisite to joining a new RC cannot be issued.
