Rotary Uganda Project

The Rotary Club of Shanghai is supporting not only major signature projects like the 'Gift-of-Life' project but also supports smaller projects globally. One of these, which Terry strongly supports, is a project in Uganda focused on water and sanitation. Therefore also two global grants have been applied for, ROTARY Global Grant 1 143 503 and ROTARY Global Grant 11 525 933..

Target of the project is to supply a village in Uganda with much needed greenhouses and help with setting up a plantation. The green houses will be used to grow fruits and vegetables and will be learning tools for the local farmers. A first green house has now been set up at the St. Paul Kaaso Primary School (see also photo). The pine tree plantation which had also been set up as a teaching and supply facility in the meantime saw trees tall enough so that they had to be pruned. Overall an excellent example of the collaborative joint effort which Rotarians excel at. A possible next step could be a fresh water supply system for the Kibira area.

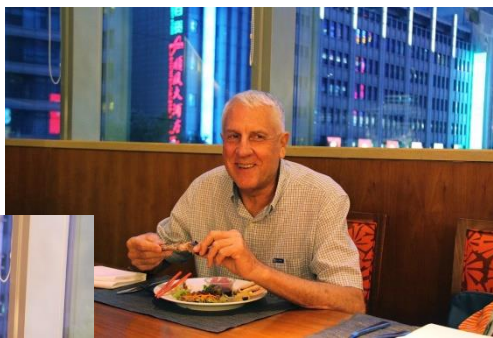
