Rotary Fighting Disease

Rotary's top priority is the eradication of polio, but our members take on far greater responsibilities to fight disease. They set up health camps and training facilities in undeveloped countries and in communities struggling with HIV/AIDS and malaria. They also design and build the infrastructure for doctors, nurses, governments, and partners to reach the one in six people in the world who can't afford to pay for health care. Disease prevention and treatment takes on many forms, from supporting studies to helping immunize people to improving drinking water and the sanitation infrastructure. The world relies on Rotary to tackle these global challenges, and to set an example for others to follow.

70 years ago in the city of Chengdu, Sichuan Province, China, Chengtu Rotary Club (成都扶輪社) had already exemplified Rotary action on disease prevention on anti-Tuberculosis campaign. See the attached news clipping from a local newspaper in May 1945. And also remember that at that time a war was still raging in China, yet these Rotarians did find time and resources to engage in this kind of work.
