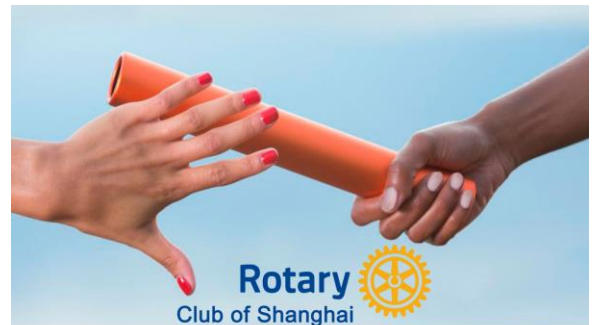

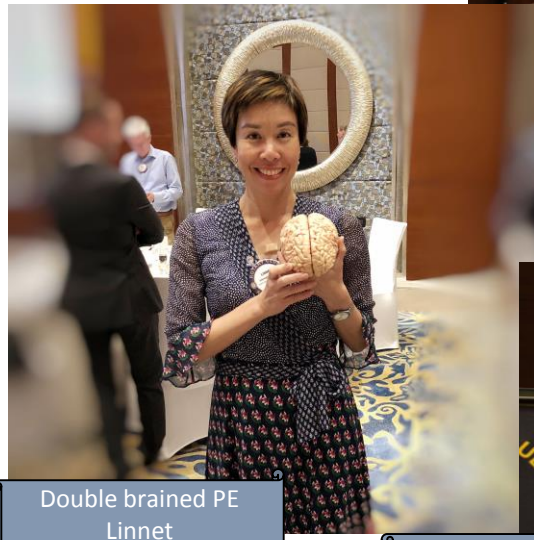
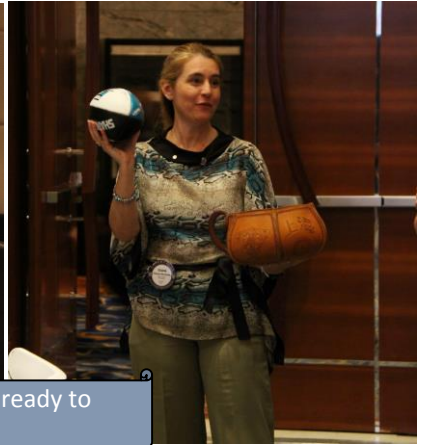
President Motosan closed our dinner meeting with our traditional toast "neuroplastic".
