

She manages a multi-disciplinary team of over twenty therapists and psychologists, providing a full range of assessment and therapeutic services to children and adolescents in need. Fiona is a fully qualified Child Protection Social Worker from the UK, who has worked in local government safeguarding services across England.

Her experience to date has been focused on investigating and responding to the most serious cases of child abuse and neglect, initiating legal care proceedings and forcibly removing children from abusive home environments. Most recently she has been developing and utilising practice models for effective safeguarding in the international community of Shanghai.
