### The success of Rotary Youth Service in Shanghai

In 2010 Rotary added Youth Service as the fifth avenue of service to its traditional services (Club Service, Vocational Service, Community Service, International Service). Ever since young people have been enthusiastically involved in Rotarian community projects, international service, and exchange programs that enrich and foster world peace and cultural understanding.

The two main venues for youth activities at Rotary are (1) Rotaract, a club for young adults ages 18-30 and (2) Interact, a club for young people ages 12-18. Both can be either community based or school based.

The Rotary Club of Shanghai currently sponsors 3 Rotaract and 7 Interact Clubs, a world record for a single Rotary club.

Does this sponsorship consume resources? There certainly are some start-up cost and minor expenses such as meal fees when Rotaractors and Interacters are invited to RC events. But Rotaract and Interact clubs are independent clubs, so they do their service projects on their own. Youth clubs even co-sponsor service projects with the RCS. A typical example is the recently completed Chetza Water project, co-sponsored with the Rotaract Club of Shanghai and the Rotaract Club of HULT Shanghai. Some Interact clubs also donated money for Nepal disaster relief together with the RCS earlier this year.

Moreover, many Rotaractor and Interactor volunteers have supported Rotary projects or events.

Actually rather than draining resources, youth has brought vitality and variety to our club's activities! The Rotaract Club of Shanghai for example has organized many fun events in Shanghai such as the food drive, the dragon boat race, the Swimarathon, the Run in Blue etc., in which many RCS members joined.

In Interact clubs, the majority of the members are Chinese students. Unlike Rotary and Rotaract, school based Interact clubs can admit

Chinese students because they exist in the legally established schools. This gives a great opportunity for us, the expats-only club, to grow deeper roots in the local community.

### **RYLA 2016**

Dear fellow Rotarians,

It is my pleasure to report that the first ever Rotary Youth Leadership Awards Program (RYLA) in PR of China was successfully completed!

Our first RYLA lasted from 25th of October to 12-16th of November 2015 with part of the training in Shanghai and then a four day camp at Moganshan mountain in Zhejiang province. The participants of our first of program were students and young professionals ages 19-26.

We had 35 participants, from 19 different countries, from 6 Universities in Shanghai and Beijing. Among the participants we had 9 members from three Rotaract Clubs, Shanghai, Shanghai West and Beijing. We also had, unfortunately, only one Percy Chu scholar this year.

The concept of this RYLA was a 1+4 days of leadership training with focus on characteristics of good leaders. The theme was based on social enterprises.

What was unique about this RYLA program is that each participant had a personal profile created through a series of surveys and peer reviews and reflections. Participants had the opportunity to recognize their strengths and weaknesses through various activities and reflection sessions, and actively work on improving themselves with help of our coaches and their team members.

How successful this approach was can be best described by the fact that there were even tears during our reflection sessions, we are calling ourselves a family now and we have pledges of lifetime friendship! You should see the moments posted on wechat accounts!

We will have a new Rotaract club formed out of RYLA participants, and lot of them will join the existing clubs. Truly an amazing and unforgettable experience.

I can proudly say that we achieved all the goals we set for ourselves with this program!
