Mr. Chung To is the founder & chairperson of Chi Heng Foundation. Mr. To started his international career by studying in the US, earning a Bachelor's degree at Columbia and a Master's degree from Harvard. In his illustrious business career he held several positions, namely Vice President at BNP Paribas Group; Associate Director at UBS; & Analyst at Lehman Brothers. Rotary Fun Facts

There are more than 1.2 Million Rotarians all over the world in more than 33,000 Rotary Clubs in more than 200 countries in all geographic areas. The Rotary Ambassadorial Scholarships is the world's largest, privately funded scholarship program. Providing vitamin A supplements during polio National Immunization Days has averted an estimated 1.5 million childhood deaths since 1998 – testimony to the “plus” in PolioPlus. The first service project of the first Rotary club of Chicago was installation of public toilets in the city. The first Rotaract Club was formed in Charlotte, North Carolina, USA. Rotarians in the United States make up 28% of all Rotarians worldwide. Nauru and formerly known as Pleasant Island, is an island country in Micronesia in the South Pacific. Its nearest neighbor is Banaba Island in Kiribati, 182 miles to the east. It has the least amount of any Rotarians in the world, numbering only 11.
