Maya

Maya is one of the oldest western restaurants in Shanghai still in existence. It is not easy to find – within a residential compound along Julu Lu, on the second floor of the sports club. It offers self-described 'Mexican-Californian' food – sorry, TexMex lovers are out of place. The food quality is generally excellent, as are the drinks, whether it is the wine menu or the cocktails at the bar. Last time we had the blackened Tuna steak, wonderfully succulent and tasty, and the honey-glazed duck breast, which also was meaty and avoided the dryness which often happens with duck.

Maya also has a bar area, which is nice for a good after-dinner cocktail. There is also a Mexican – themed brunch possible.

In summary, if you like good food and if you want to avoid the heavy TexMex fare, Maya is an excellent (though pricey) choice.

PS: For all chess-players, every Monday evening there is also a chess tournament at Maya in an adjacent room, as the owner of Maya is an ardent chess lover.
