Gift of Life experience

My first contact with the Gift of Life (GOL) project was when my husband came home after a meeting with Rotary Club, saying that he has chosen to be part of the GOL committee and that he truly feels he is part of something meaningful. I remember he shared with me that over 1000 children with congenital heart defects have been saved through the Gift of Life Program in China. Weeks later, after one of the GOL conference calls he said smiling "You know something? I've just volunteered you to give a hand in this great project."

Though I had scarce information about it I agreed to get involved. I have found myself part of a project with a long history in The Rotary Club of Shanghai. It is a program very well thought through, well organized, presently managed by just a few very capable people. This handful of people are attracting funds, handling the finances, managing the relations with the hospitals, doing the case analysis, keeping track of every case, and so on. At the time I joined the GOL team, the missing piece was getting to know the children whose surgeries are financed through the GOL and trying to personally connect the Rotary Club with the people that are being saved through the efforts of its members.

Consequently I have started to go to the hospitals, meet the patients and understand better their situation.

The first time I stepped in the patient's room I was accompanied by two members of the GOL and two of my children. I felt nervous, not knowing exactly what to expect. We met FanJingYu, a boy of 6 years old coming from Henan province. His disease was discovered not long after he was born and he has had 3 surgeries so far. As his dad is handicapped his family relies mainly on his grandfather for their living. He was pretty shy but smiled to us most of the time, not understanding very well why we were there but happy that we brought toys. The surgery was a success so after his complete recovery he will most probably be able to live a normal life. To his grandmother, we were the representatives of the "Society" that had an important role in giving her grandchild a new chance in life. I could see in her eyes, tormented by long days of disquiet and worry, a feeling of deep gratitude. Before leaving we gave her our telephone number and our emails so in case they want to contact us later on and share anything related to Fan JingYu, she would know who we are and how to reach us.

After leaving the hospital I stopped a moment and thought about what this experience has brought along and how did it impact me. I realized that sometimes I live my life as if it were a marathon, running continuously from one place to another, completing task after task, duty after duty. There are too many times that I forget to enjoy what I do and cherish what I have. Meeting the children that were born with a severe heart defect, in an unprivileged situation, that have just gone through a surgery but still carrying a smile on their faces provides me with a precious moment of reflection. Life is truly a gift and health is its foundation, realizing this and valuing them is what brings along happiness. I have met children of different ages, with different family status so every visit brings along a different mixture of feelings. However, giving some time to set a liaison between the Rotary Club and the *persons* behind what we call *cases*, helps changing one's perspective on things and favors a rearrangement of one's priorities in life.

To conclude I would say that every visit is a rewarding exchange of gifts.
