Japan-China relationship - Kazuyuki Katayama

Tonight we will be honoured by the presence of Mr. Kazuyuki Katayama. Mr. Katayama is a diplomat who started his carrer by entering into Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan (MOFA) in 1983. Since then his carrier has been growing and moving fast, with prestigious positions, from China to US, to Europe, to US again and back to China where he currently is Consul-General in Shanghai since 2015.

Mr. Katayama has variety of educational background including PhD (International Relations) of University of Malaya, M.A.(Arts and Sciences) of Harvard University, and B.A. (Law) of Kyoto University. He also studied in Hong Kong and Beijing in 1980's.

This year marks the 45th anniversary of diplomatic relations between Japan and China. Mr. Katayama is the first to say that 45 years is not yet long enough to mature political relationship between China and Japan but the two countries are neighbors and this cannot be changed.

In his lecture, he will lead through several important guidelines for considering future Japan-China relations.


On Monday afternoon, Rtns. Rita and Tiziana visited the Shanghai Children's Medical Center located in Dongfang Rd, more precisely their Hematology and Oncology Center where they met Helena from RSDBT 人生大不同 to strengthen our relationship in order to create a meaningful long term project to give relief to ill kids, one of the areas of focus of Rotary. It has been a touchy experience and a volcano of ideas came out. There are so many activities we could be engaged in and, why not, there are even some good possibility for applying for some Global Grant. All the brainstorm will obviously follow our internal procedure: first submission of ideas and projects to Service Committee and, if approved, they will move on to Board for approval. So... stay tuned, news is in the air. Just a small preview to satisfy someone curiosity: applications for Santa Claus and his Elves could open soon. One Elf already found but we need the Big Bearded Boss and few other Buddy-Elves!!!

Kashin-Beck Disease China Phase 2 Project update, approaching Global Grant (GG)!

Rotary Club of Shanghai KBD team are working on the Kashin Beck project phase 2 into China Qinghai region now as we have at 30 June 2017 closed of successfully Phase 1 KBD project in Tibet (in Line with new China NGO laws) with 30 % reduction of the disease in the regions where the KBD Team was allowed to operate, and this thanks Partially with the 7 year support of the Rotary club of Shanghai ongoing support .

The kBD team has decided to enter China Nomadic region in Qinghai and start a new project in this region with 2 local partners with China compliance so we will build on the 25 years in Tibet and transfer all the knowledge to our local partners in Qinghai with scientific and project management under the control of the Belgian scientific team under the leadership of Dr. Francoise Matthieu.

We are working on a Global grant with as objective to raise 80,000 U\$ as a Rotary International Grant with Rotary Club of Shanghai (RCS) as hosting Club and The RC Mayenne Bretagne as International Partner . Regions of the Tibetan Plateau, Sichuan and Qinghai, are mainly populated by poor and uneducated families. Whether farmers or nomads, they have no notion of basic hygiene and health.



To prevent the numerous sanitary problems, KBD Fund and its partners set up trainings on health education, as well as hygiene promotion. Linked to greenhouse construction, nutritional troubles are also broached and we insist on the importance to provide a diversified diet for the good growth of the children. We well remember the kind donation offered by our member Rtn. Mark Hunziker who delivered 1,000 muesli boxes to the area last year. For the implementation, KBDF will work in close collaboration with 2 local partners: Ganglha and Qinghai Loving & Care Center. Both organizations have been working in the area for several years as social entrepreneurs and have setting-up social, educational and development activities. The project was designed by KBDF, with advices from the two partners who have better knowledge of the fieldwork in Qinghai.

The goals of the KBD Phase 2 GG are:

- To change food habits of the underprivileged Tibetan population, with a special focus on children.
- To improve nutritional and health statutes of children.
- To prevent bone diseases.
- To improve general knowledge on health and hygiene among Tibetan communities.
- To train villagers for the efficiency and sustainability of the activities

It is known that diversified diet is the base for a good general health, KBD Fund and its locals partners swill build 40 greenhouses in the villages. Thanks to these greenhouses, families will have, all year long, fresh vegetable rich in vitamins, a very important point for the good development of their children! Together we can Make a Difference!
