JANUARY IS VOCATIONAL SERVICE MONTH

Rotary International defines Vocational Service as:

1. Adhering to and promoting the highest ethical standards in all occupations;
2. Recognizing the value of all useful occupations, not just those that are pursued by Rotarians; and
3. Contributing one's vocational talents to meeting the needs of the community.

Vocational Service should be in our thoughts and action all year long.

Vocational Service options:

1. Conducting a program to recognize high ethical standards and public values in the community.
2. Organizing at least one professional networking event in which club members can meet other local professionals and introduce them to Rotary.
3. Sponsoring a career day in which club members bring young people to their places of business to inform them about career opportunities.
4. Post 《The 4-Way Test》 on a prominent billboard in your community.
5. Display 《The 4-Way Test》 and/or the 《Rotarians Code of Conduct》 in your office or work place and use it as a conversation starter to tell your colleagues about Rotary's commitment to business ethics and personal integrity.

- Serve others by lending your unique skills to a project — perhaps by joining a Rotarian Action Group or by becoming a member of The Rotary Foundation Cadre of Technical Advisers
