

Another very busy busy dinner meeting, full of news and special guests. We started with the Four Way Test led by Rtn. Daniel Tweer followed by visiting Rotarians and guests introduced by David. Announcements started immediately, offering an overview over upcoming events and focusing on our club big annual party. Tiziana stressed out the important of being there to support the club, to support GOL and of course to have fun and enjoy a nice evening fellowship. She also gave some tips to those who eventually feel embarrassed in dressing up. There are no more excuses now! Moto then updated the status of GOL online fundraising. PP Andrew introduced an upcoming event "Friendship Tree Planting", following Paul Harris steps who planted one of the first in Shanghai in 1935. A group of volunteers will plant a first symbolic tree in a special education school in Pudong on a week day to have the possibility of interacting with kids before April, 22nd. Then Moto invited a Chinese Rotaractor from Nagoya Atsuta club Chen Jiayi to introduce Rotary Yoneyama Memorial Foundation from which she got scholarship for her PhD course, and how she became a Rotaractor in Japan. Our Michel then introduced a special guest for the night, Doctor Francoise Mathieu, who updated us over the KBD Gift of Health Qinghai, running for Global Grant as well. She explained the main causes of the disease and how they could be controlled and reduced, especially after a 25 years experience of work in Western China, one of the most underdeveloped area of the country. It is necessary to protect next generations and insure the harmonious development and growth of children. Pilot project for Qinghai will start in upcoming September by targeting groups. Activities will focus on training on nutrition and food diversification, health and hygiene promotion. Immediately after it was Classification time, tonight by our Dave Smith. He told us about his background, his childhood and his big family showing a lovely picture taken during his 90 years old granny birthday. He comes from a Rotarian family, born by "Presidential" parents. He told us about his profession and about the year he went on tour with Disney on Ice as an electrician. He then ended to China, in Fonshan then in Nanjing looking for a more lucrative occupation until he landed into fruit trade during its boom. He showed us several pictures about his "office" and told us about anecdotes. We must say "this man is on the filed!". As Dave was already standing, who better than him to run the saddle, which ended with a live auction over a nice coffee set offered by our Secretary Michelle. Last but not least we arrived at our clue moment, our energetic speaker Reto Bless talking about Cloud and how to move a business into it. He firstly introduced himself and then offered background information as a tool to make us reflect over technology. He explained the cloud and the client access. He made terminology more accessible and offered a plan made of five steps to approach the cloud.


