She was also previously a contributor of political and economic analysis for the Economist Intelligence Unit.

Julia is completing a PhD on market access for foreign companies in China, with focusing on the automotive and energy sectors. She has a master's degree from the London School of Economics and Political Science and a bachelor's degree from Georgetown University's School of Foreign Service. Julia speaks Mandarin, is a native German speaker and is fluent in French.
