# Visit to the 7,500 Tree Project – By Michel de Vrient



On Saturday 14th of September at 21:00 the RCS Team left from Pudong airport and arrived in Xining in Qinghai Province at 01:00 to visit the 7,500 RCS trees site.

Saturday morning at 09:00 our local partner Robert Nyanchak the founder of Ganglha (www.ganglha.org) picked us up with up to head to the project site after 5 h drive at 2500 m altitude through highways and hours of 4x4 mountain sandy roads we reached the RCS 7,500 Tree site whilst enjoying an amazing scenic roads.



At 14:00 we arrived at the site and started a beautiful descend through small steep mountain walkway surrounded by sandstone mountains and Turquoise water area bordering this dessert area situated alongside China's First Yellow River Reservoir Dam. The growing desert is a threat both for the water reservoir and the local livelihood.



In the coming year, this initiative may be scaled up to be implemented with other communities in the area that are affected by the desertification we witnessed during our visit . The new trees will benefit the local communities surrounding the desert, restore the grassland ecosystem and bring a sustainable community livelihood. We reached Xining at 23h00 back after a 5h night driving along trucks with a divert sense of road safety and we reached our Shanghai homes back 52 h having witnessed the impact each RCs member has started for the generations to follow.





Communities rounding the Desert are suffering from environmental degradation due to lack of Vegetation and trees, the soil condition are such that Rain water runs-off almost as soon as it lands, increasing

the rates of soil erosion.

At 15h20, we reached the Site which is beautiful located and fenced and surrounded by a Fjord type of water way.

We observed in this site area 1 the trees planted by the local volunteers in April 2018 growing up nicely about 5 months after the
