

Business Networking Recap

As the end of the Rotary year is upon us, we gathered for the last Business Network meeting to discuss the highly requested subject of innovation.

From manufacturing new materials to disruptive profit models, our guest panellists presented the many ways current challenges affect how companies approach innovation.

Heidi Berg, the CMO of Waste2Wear, introduced the role of innovation in developing sustainable resources. We learned how her company is revolutionizing the fashion industry by turning waste like PET bottles into high-quality polyester fabrics—effectively transforming the future of one of the most demanding industries in the world.

Marian Danko, a well-known entrepreneur in Shanghai, discussed how networking plays a crucial role in fostering innovation in China. His company, WeHustle, has become a bridge between startups, incubators, and corporations alike, providing a wide range of services to those who want to connect and build meaningful relationships.

Lastly, Paul Lin, a business consultant and NYU adjunct professor, discussed innovation in profit models and how companies world-wide tackle the challenges of staying relevant by disrupting and reinventing traditional business models in the digital era.







With a topic of such relevance, it is of no surprise we had 30+ attendees lively discussing the role of innovation in the modern economy. Rotarians and guests engaged in a conversation about what innovation means for their particular business and how to achieve it.

"I was particularly interested in the subject of digital innovation", mentioned Christian Kober. "I wanted to learn what has been done and how to implement it in our industry, now I'm eager to share what I've learned with my son, especially about how important networking is for business in this country".

Our visiting Rotarian Tarik shared his thoughts on the subject of networking for innovation: "It was interesting to know about the platforms available and how it is possible to connect with people from different fields and work together, especially those interested in sustainability. We need to think differently and connect with new and fresh blood. If we consider how different the dynamic is from what was happening twenty years ago, we know that we need to be involved in the scene for us to come up with radical innovations".

All in all, the last Business Network meeting of this term was a successful exchange of ideas and perspectives. We hope all of our guests have enjoyed the discussion panel and got the motivation needed to develop new innovative solutions in their fields.

SSES, one of our interact clubs and the school where two of our rotarians, David Richardson and Naomy Pena are making a difference, would like to share that their Theatre and Visual Arts program have spent the entire semester working on an orginal performance also based on Environmental protection.

The process was designed to connect PBL to Service-Learning, based on our service-inclusive teaching and pedagogical integration models. The plot features a unique adventure through a museum that displays the last tree, inspiring environmental protection. All props and costumes are designed by VA students using recycled, reused and upscaled materials.

The performance will last an hour with three acts. Tickets are 80 yuan and open to teachers, parents and interested external partners (LIMITED to 100 tickets only). The money will fund the Shangde Forest along with the 2022 Roots and Shoots Inner Mongolia tree-planting project. Students will also perform for an elderly community partner and provide VA and Theatre tutoring for students from schools without these subjects.
