






Highlights from the last mentoring meeting

The second mentoring session as part of the RCS Career Empowerment Program was held online on Tuesday, March 29. In total, 17 mentors signed up to help the mentees to reflect and foster their development. It was the first experience of such a kind for quite a few mentors. Fortunately, the event had not only been perfectly organized by Rotarians Elizabeth, Tilman, and Naomi but the mentors had also received tailored training by professional coach Tilman in advance. During the 60-minutes-session, we practiced the responsibilities of a mentor: after building up trust and rapport, we supported the mentees in their goal setting. By asking open and thought-provoking questions and applying active listening, we tried to activate the mentee's potential and resources to let them find their own solutions and ideas on how to improve a situation or behavior.

Time flew by and from my perspective, the sessions were rewarding for both mentees and mentors, not only because of the gratefulness expressed by the mentees. So, I would like to encourage more of us to give it a try next time. Side note: this time, even two of our members used the opportunity to receive mentorship from their fellow Rotarians.

Every Tree Start From A Seed

Audrey spent the first decade of her career in marketing and communications with Edelman International Public Relations and American International Assurance (AIA) covering areas including strategic brand positioning, advertising, sponsorship marketing, corporate communications, corporate social responsibility, public relations, media and event management.

While she was with Edelman PR, Audrey's most notable project was leading the launch of British Airways' inaugural flight from London to Shanghai.

During her time with AIA, Audrey successfully managed the first corporate branding TVC and agent recruitment campaign in China. She also led efforts to coordinate all internal/ external communication across key stakeholders for a smooth transition during AIA's IPO preparations.

Attending AIA's Asia-Pacific Future Leaders Program marked a career turning point for Audrey. She discovered her passion for the social sector after getting heavily involved in a charitable fieldwork mission at an orphanage in Xi'an, Shaanxi Province.

A few years after the Future Leaders Program, Audrey made the decision to step full-time into the social sector and make it her life-long mission. Audrey first worked with SVG (Social Venture Group, a nonprofit philanthropic advisory and advocacy organization), then Shanghai Soong Ching Ling Foundation (A well known GONGO named after honorary Chairwoman of China, Madame Soong Ching Ling) and currently she is with Future Smile Charitable Foundation, a 5A-level (the highest level for NGOs in China) public fundraising foundation first established in Zhejiang Province.

During her nearly 10 years experience in the social sector, Audrey has worked on a number of charitable programs where her passion lays, including medical assistance, education for underprivileged children, special needs families and sustainable development programs. Her mission is to use her talents and experiences to make a positive impact on those who are in need, especially for vulnerable women and children.
