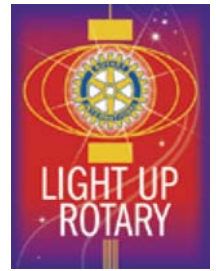

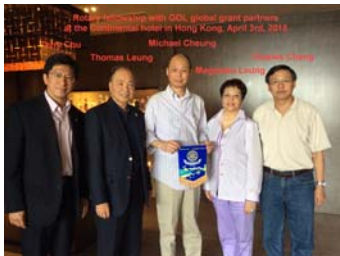

An update from the GOL & Service project committee

Committees' update - in recent two fellowships in Shanghai and Hong Kong respectively, President Frank, GOL committee chair & PN Andrew and Service project committee chair Terry met with fellow Rotarians of our first GOL global grant partners (and sister clubs) - RC Richmond Sunset, RC Luzern Seetal, and RC Hong Kong Island West. It was probably the first time that all the partners in a grant project could get together and kicked off the global grant project that had received a speedy 2-weeks approval after its submission. The GOL Committee has planned to complete all the 30+ GOL cases by the end of this Rotary year, so the committee and the hospitals will be busy. We will keep all of you posted as there will be many opportunities for your participation in our club's signature project.

We are grateful to our international partners for their continuous support to Rotary projects in China. What's more, in view of this very successful cooperation, all four parties have already agreed to joint effort again on another GOL global grant in the Rotary year 2015-16 after the current one is complete, and possibly other suitable projects as well. Indeed, it is an amazing Rotary team....



The last meeting was a fellowship meeting. It was started off, after the four-way-test naturally, by Moto giving us a report on the BBQ at Frank's place. He also introduced the new Rotary logos. He then introduced all the youth clubs which we sponsor, quite an eye-opener! But most importantly he introduced RYLA, Rotary Youth Leadership Awards. RYLA is an initiative of RI, devoted to providing young people with intensive leadership training, lasting 2-3 days. Thanks to Tara, a budget of 50,000 RMB from Gala has been secured and Moto proposed to hold a training session in November. All volunteers, please approach Moto. And, May, by the way, is the Youth Service Month.

Frank Hoffman invited all Rotarians to attend his coming training on Rotary matters on May 2nd. The last such training was also a success, attended also by many Rotaractors.

Alexandra Taulin reported on the 1st meeting of the membership committee under new leadership. Mostly the meeting was attended by French Rotarians, so non-French speakers were invited to also attend in droves.

Sam, supported by Terry Chu collected as Sergeant-at-Arms again happy money and our members seem to be a happy lot.
