Last Sunday was again Swimarathon. The Swimarathon is an annual global event to raise awareness of Polio and funds for Polio Plus, Rotary's global signature project.

Four teams competed – exhibiting wildly varying levels of swimming competence. There was no clear winner, though with a participation of 59 people, Rotarians from 4 different clubs in China, Rotaractors and Interactors the event definitely was a success with regards to raising awareness and funds. The venue sponsor will donate 3,200RMB from the event proceeds, which will be matched by Bill & Melinda Foundation for 6,400RMB, enabling Rotary to provide 2318 vaccines for the kids in need.
