e-Learning Project update – Wesley Chiu

Nearly one year and a half ago RCS sponsored to build an online classroom in a remote village primary school in Sichuan. This school has only 49 students, mostly left-behind children. The school does not have English or music teachers on site as people with these skills do not want to stay in a small village. With RCS sponsored eLearning Project, the students are now having real time interactive English, Music and Personal Development classes online on weekly basis.

Do you want to see the current progress? Join us tonight as Wesley Chiu will share with us a report on this semester. Wesley Chiu is one of our RCS members. He now serves as the Global General Counsel for Goodbaby Group. Apart from his work, he volunteers in education. He is a board director of United World College Changshu China and an external lecturer at Shanghai Jiaotong University for LLM students. He is also one of the founding members of Project VolunOnline, a NGO pioneering in using videoconference technology for 100+ volunteers from cities around the world to provide weekly real time interactive online classes to 2000+ left-behind children in 30+ remote villages in China.
