

First ever Zoom Meeting of the RCS on Tuesday, February 25, 2020

Last week saw the first ever zoom - meeting of the RC Shanghai. Organised by Rotarian Thilo Koeppen, a panel of four illustrious specialists gave their insights on the Coronavirus epidemic from several points of view: medical (Dr. Warren Ho, Parkway), legal (Ulrike Glueck, CMS), economic (Mary Boyd, The Economist) and industrial (Dr. Nils Lessmann, BASF). The meeting went very smoothly – in the esteemed opinion of your editor not always true when using electronic conferencing, Dr. Ho explained why the Coronavirus is less terrifying and more terrifying than the influenza virus at the same time. Ms. Glueck gave valuable legal advice, how to deal with labour issues and also if and how force majeure can be invoked. Mary Boyd highlighted the impact on the local and global economy, based on several scenarios and a special focus also at supply chain disruption. Lastly Nils explained to us what it means to manage a thousand people across China, maintaining business and safety at the same time.



Organizer Thilo said, such a meeting was certainly a first in the 100 years history of the Rotary Club of Shanghai. Being an alternative to the Covid-19 hit regular meeting schedule, it turned out to be an awesome platform bringing RCS fellows together and spread information all around the world.




