Our honorary members

The RC Shanghai currently has 5 honorary members. But what does this actually mean and who can become an honorary member?

Eligible are persons who have distinguished themselves by service for Rotary ideals. Those persons considered friends of Rotary for their support of Rotary’s cause may be elected to honorary membership. The term of such membership shall be as determined by the board of the club in which they hold membership.

What rights does such a membership confer?

Honorary members are exempt from the payment of dues. They are entitled to attend all meetings and enjoy all the other privileges of the club in which they hold such membership. No honorary member of a club is entitled to any rights or privileges in any other club, except for the right to visit other clubs without being the guest of a Rotarian. (more in the RI bylaws).

End Polio Now Status

Afghanistan

Fewer than 10 cases have been reported in Afghanistan so far in 2016. Strengthening immunization campaigns is key to stopping polio in the country.

Pakistan

According to experts, Pakistan will prove the biggest challenge to global eradication efforts. However, we’ve seen recent progress in Pakistan, with the country reporting a near 50 percent reduction in cases in 2016 compared to the same time in 2015.

Africa

Nigeria saw its last polio case on 24 July 2014. When all of Africa goes three years without a case of polio, WHO will certify the region as polio-free.
