Inspired by the support Wuhan received from international Rotarians, especially in from Rotary Clubs in France, a group of local French Rotarians decided to support France when COVID-19 arrived there.

They decided to concentrate their effort on the regions in France most affected by the Pandemic, namely the Paris and Île de France region (Robert Debré Hospital, Henri Mondor Hospital, Saint Maurice Hospital, Melun Hospital, Armand Briard Hospital and 5 homes for the elderly) and the Grand Est region (Emile Muller Hospital and various associations)..

On the French side the RC Paris Est, RC Mayenne, RC Paris Sud Est, RC Paris Champs Elysées, RC Mulhouse Europe, RC Nogent Le Perreux, RC Le Bourget-Aulnay, CIP France China and private donors became involved, while on the Chinese side the RC Shanghai, RC Shanghai .

Élysée and RC Pudong Lijiazui contributed.

Coordinated by the CIP (= French for ICC: Inter Country Committees) France-China, the support took off in May 2020 with the supply of 430 kg of nursing gowns intended for hospitals and care homes.

Our last meeting saw us again visiting our “normal” venue in the Shanghai Marriott City Center. Alessandro started the evening with a professional reading of the Four Wat Test. The evenings main event and certainly one of our highlights since the end of the lock-down was a speech by Dr. Ho (who previously already had informed us about COVID-19 in the Zoom session organized by Thilo). Dr. Ho gave us an update and an outlook into the future. On the one hand certainly a relief, as the situation has vastly improved, on the other hand the future seems to be a future in which we have to live with the virus for the foreseeable future. Another highlight was certainly the willingness of Rotarians to support good causes, in this case a medical student from Zimbabwe, Chiedza, who due to the dire economic situation is struggling with her school fees for her final year in Dalian. Rotarians opened their purses and 5 Rotarians could ring the bell, Jeff twice so. 7040 RMB could be raised this evening, by 15 members, 1 visitor and 3 friends.




