Rotary Leadership Awards: A recipient report

Since 2004 the TSI (TECC Summer Institute) has been promoting the development of education in schools in central and western China. The program is meant to foster communication and cultural understanding between China and other countries.

In 2014 TSI organized 4 teams, each of which consisted of 10-15 college students, to travel

and work in schools in western China. The college students were from universities including Tsinghua, Peking, Fudan, Shanghai JiaoTong, Cornell, Stanford, Smith College and Hong Kong. These volunteers trained students and teachers in English and computer technology.


As a huge gap exists in educational quality between eastern and western China, the project actively addresses this gap. The TSI project provides

opportunities for teachers to get training in teaching methods and skills. The program also helps the teachers learn about advanced teaching resources. The long-term goal of the

project is to reduce the educational differences between the west and east and to improve job prospects for students graduating from schools in the west.

The program won 1st place award in Student Category during the 2014 Rotary Leadership Awards held at the Swissotel. The prize was a total of 10,000 RMB. The normal project costs include learning materials, transportation, and meals. The funds from Rotary were used for materials and meals in each of the programs in Gansu, Henan, Yunan, and Chongqing. The Rotary Club's donation enabled the program to improve the quality of materials and experience of the teachers, students and volunteers. TSI has been very grateful for these additional funds but especially for the publicity and recognition that comes with it.
