Effective Leadership in China

Dr. Wendong Deng

Our speaker, Dr. Wendong Deng, will talk about a topic which is close to the everyday business challenges most Rotarians here in Shanghai face.. How to be an effective leader in China?

Leadership styles deemed effective in one culture may not necessarily be effective in others. Traditional values, communist ideologies, economic reform, and Western management theories and practices, all matters for the effective leadership in China. This speech introduces the leadership style in China and the leadership perception of Chinese young employees. International managers will gain insights on how to become true leaders in China, and meanwhile, Chinese managers to learn how to become international leaders.

Dr. Wendong Deng has a Chinese background and is very experienced in the international arena; he has worked for Siemens Mobile and TÜV SÜD both in Europe and in China. From 2006 to 2011, Wendong founded and managed a business consulting company in Shanghai, which helped European companies to enter China and Chinese companies to realize their overseas expansion strategies.

Wendong has a Master of Science degree from Technical University Munich and MBA degree from Shanghai Jiao Tong University. More recently he received his Ph.D. in management from Erasmus University Rotterdam. Currently he works as the Chief Representative of KIT Intercultural Professionals in Shanghai. Based on this experience he is well positioned to deliver knowledge and practical tools about China.
