


The 1st Edition & the 250th Edition

Esteemed reader, fellow Rotarian, today marks the 250th edition of the venerable Pagoda. The term '250th' has to be handled with care though. Firstly, this is the 250th edition of the 'modern' Pagoda, the newsletter of the current Rotary Club of Shanghai. Secondly the origins of the modern Pagoda are shrouded in mystery. Obviously it was firstly printed when we were still 'Expatriate Rotarians and Friends in Shanghai'. But a 'first edition' has been difficult to trace, even though this is the age of computing and an internet which supposedly forgets nothing. Another potential date for an official first edition would be 8th of February 2006 when our club was rechartered. Yet even the edition of that day remains elusive.

And not to be forgotten, the first Pagoda ever was actually printed on Sept. 2, 1919. It might therefore well be that today you are looking at the 1750^{th} edition. Nevertheless, whether it is the 1750th, the 250th or may-

be just the 467th edition, we hope that you continue to enjoy reading the Pagoda and that we will continue the tradition well into the future.


George L. Treadwell Shanghai Rotary Club - Charter Member & Club Secretary The first PAGODA editor

The first editor of 《The Rotary Pagoda 》 -- weekly news publication by The Shanghai Rotary Club since 1919 -- was George L. Treadwell. Rotarian George, who was a native of Massachusetts, USA, and assistant manager of the Chinese American Publishing Company in Shanghai, was also a charter member and served as the Club Secretary. From the archives, we have found three photos of George L. Treadwell. The first one was taken in June 1920 when George L. Treadwell was the chief delegate of four to attend the 11th Annual Convention of Rotary International held at Atlantic City, USA. This was the first time China's representatives attended the Rotary International Convention. In this photo, you can see George is on the left inside the rickshaw traces.



The third photo was taken in early 1943 during a reception in honor of Madame Chiang Kai-Shek (蔣介石夫人宋美齡女士) by Chicago Rotarians. George appears on the extreme right.

After George L. Treadwell returned to the United States, he joined Chicago Rotary Club and later elected as Club Secretary. So, George had taken two times of the "First" – Club Secretary of the "First Club in China" and "First Club in The World".

The second photo was taken in February 1933 when The Rotary Club of Chicago, USA, celebrated its 25th Anniversary. In the photo below, you can see George L. Treadwell stood at the right end of the back row. This photo was published on the March 1933 Issue of [The Rotarian] Monthly Magazine, Page 38.


