

#### **Charity Golf Tournament**

It had been a long time in the making – the Charity Golf Tournament. The first ideas were generated as early as December last year, but work started in earnest only on Feb. 28<sup>th</sup>. With only few intermissions the working group met every Sunday. Key target was to collect money to support the YouDao foundation, a Hongkong registered charity which is focused on providing learning opportunities for migrant worker's children in Shanghai. At the same time, naturally the RC Shanghai does not shy away from publicity.

The great day was May 20<sup>th</sup>, actually carefully chosen for it auspicious sound and meaning in Chinese. Thus Terri also gave out red roses to every participant and everybody joined in saying 'Wo ai ni' – though there was no (reported) smooching. Despite the appalling weather 73 players attended, plus about 10 non players, to register at about 10:00 and to take up their clubs at 11:30. The winners were Stephen Mooney (best gross) and Kieran O'Donnell (best net).

But golf was not everything. Also the best dressed golfers were elected and the best selfie shot. Only disappointment was that there was no hole-in-one. Such an event would have garnered the grand prize of a flight to Jeju Island by private jet. Well, next time there should be a private 747 sponsored. From a charity point of view the event was also a great success. 73 players, 5 individual donors, 40 in-kind sponsors and 6 personal gift donations helped to collect appr. 195k RMB for charity, far exceeding the 120k targeted.






#### **Dues Payment**


