Exploratory visit to the Yue Miao Yuan Home for the Disabled

On January 7th members of the service committee visited the Yue Miao Yuan Home for the Disabled. Target of the visit was to work with the disabled and at the same time to explore if we might set up a club project supporting this home.

Yue Miao Yuan is a privately-run home for the mentally or physically disabled, with 140 residents in two locations (Putuo & Minhang). Yue Miao Yuan was first contacted by Sam Tung to explore what project opportunities there are for the Rotary Club of Shanghai. Saturday Jan. 14th Linnet, Tracy and Andrew joined Sam in an exploratory visit. The outcome is a three level proposal. (1) help for residents whose families face financial hardship, (2) refurbish their property in order to help lease negotiations with the landlord or (3) help to train their residents through Andrew's company in care treatment. These proposals will be presented to the Service Project Committee.
