A Gift from Shanghai to Bristol Rotary Club, Great Britain, 1929

It was the year 1929 when a stone from the Great Wall of China was donated by Shanghai Rotary Club to Bristol Rotary Club, Great Britain, via Mrs. Hawkins who was supposed to be a Shanghai Rotarian's wife. It is in pristine condition having being kept for 80 plus years in the leather travelling case it was transported in. As you all can see from the picture the name "The Rotary Club of Shanghai" is engraved on metal plate in perfect conditions together with the original leather case. This piece of interesting information comes to us directly on 17 August 2017 from Past President Peter J. Guttridge, Bristol Rotary Club, of which wishes to keep this special artefact into Rotary Family but recently they received some offers by two auction houses. It is well understandable that their goal is to raise funds for service projects. Locally, Bristol is working hand in hand with the Meadow Vale Community Association to renovate a dilapidated community centre in Speedwell, one of the poorest and most neglected areas of the city. The refurbished centre will provide a community cafe and a range of vital social, medical and cultural facilities where none currently exist. The Club is aiming to raise upwards of £100.000.

Internationally, Bristol has worked for many years in Nepal funding projects to bring fresh water to villages and to rebuild schools following the terrible earthquake. Together with sister Rotary clubs, they raised £53,000 to alleviate some of the impact of that earthquake. The Club is also actively contributing to the worldwide effort by Rotary to eradicate Polio from the world with the support of Bill and Melinda Gates – and Bristol is nearly there! Bristol Rotary Club is celebrating his Centennial Anniversary this year and extends his invitation to their Centennial Ball Celebration which will be held on Saturday, November 4th together with the same best wishes to Shanghai where would be the place of the 100 years of Rotary in 2019.
