### Highlights from the last meeting

Our meeting started by the Four Way Test led by Rtn. Pradeep Kumar and President Motosan introduced visiting Rotarians and guests. Banner exchange time saw two visiting Rotarians, Dr. Sushil Khurana from RC Gurgaon, India and Dr. Adrian Cheong **RC HKIW** 

During announcements dedicated moments Michel dV presented our upcoming Family Day at Shoufeng Kindergarten in cooperation with Youdao in aid of migrant kids on June, 16th and recruited volunteers. Then RACS President Josh made a call for sponsor and participants for Run in Blue event which will be held at the end of June (see flyer), reminding last year it counted over 800 attendees. During his presentation he invited a special guest, Mr. Su Zhen from CIPDR, to introduce Down's Syndrome, cause supported by Ru in Blue this year, and the Sweet Angel Campaign.

Our Pradeep Kumar introduced himself and his life during Classification time. He told us about his 42 years in India, 9 years in Japan and 16 years in China. He shared with us his knowledge about the Theory of Constraints (TOC), a subject that helped saving 200M USD every year since 1986. He realized he was working too hard to achieve results by dividing things into smaller sets while TOC calls for understanding the whole and then focusing on its constraints in order to achieve significant improvements. And benefits are immediate. TOC is great for solving interpersonal conflicts and personal dilemmas.

After Classification, Dr. Sushil Khurana was invited to stage for a brief introduction. He is RCS Global Grant Auditor. He mentioned on how Rotary is an international family where exchanges and communication are great and welcomed. Saddle time was led by Rtn. Thierry Melango, supported by Michel dV. Rtn. Michael Sikora brought his promised Apfelstrudel for auction, which was sold out in 2 minutes!!! So Michael had to promise he will bring a bigger one for next time. Clue speech of the evening was about Mindfulness, how to train mind to manage attention. Our speaker Brandon was incredible and offered a relaxing and humorous presentation. We experienced a 3-minutes training, focusing on breath and mind. 3-minutes mindfulness training once a day is the best way to get stared. Give a try right now, sit up straight, relaxed and alert... How do you feel now? Our meeting ended by traditional President Motosan's toast for mindfulness.
