
#### **Relief for Wuhan**

On Monday January 27<sup>th</sup> Shanghai Rotarian Michel was contacted with an urgent request to help supporting a maternity ward in Wuhan. Michel, who is also chairing the KBD effort, immediately started to take action. He contacted PP Linnet who is now in the US who immediately started working on getting support in the Bay Area. This action call resulted in 250.000 gloves being shipped from San Francisco. In a second step 82.000 masks and 150 protective suits were donated via Jojo Meng who is working in Israel.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> relief mission then was in cooperation with "Doctors without Borders" (MSF). Usually MSF only co-operates with governments. For the first time MSF shipped to a private foundations, namely Frank Yi's foundation, in China: 38,000 masks. In total 41.000US\$ in donations were received, 120.000 masks, 150 protective suits and 240.000 surgical gloves were delivered. With Terry Chu orchestrating the whole operation, Tracy did great work ensuring transportation, as well as students from Tongii University and in Beijing who helped in the logistics. The Rotary Clubs Champs Elysee, Paris Est, Cupertino and Shanghai all were strongly involved with donations and practical support. Many more contributed which cannot all be named here but will be named in a later "Pagoda Special".
