ings, as the participants admitted. With regard to vaccines there was quite some discussion on the safety of the vaccines, though the overall consensus was that it will probably be inevitable to get a vaccination if one ever wants to be able to travel again. Again the liveliness of the discussions attested to the success of hav-

ing Rotary in Shanghai as a venue for meeting both goals of Rotary - to engage in volunteer activities but also to foster fellowship.
