

He is an Honorary Paul Harris Fellow and Rotary Peace Fellow. Since 2009, d'Arcy has delivered over 1800 presentations to more than 150,000 people in schools, universities, businesses, community groups, government events, and conferences across numerous platforms, including more than 150 Rotary presentations and keynote speeches at Rotary events, RYLA, Interact/Rotaract workshops, District Conferences and more.

d'Arcy has worked on polio eradication with UNICEF and collaborated with Rotary in Pakistan, India, Uganda, and South Sudan. He has also joined with Rotarians in Canada, New Zealand, Australia, the UK, Brunei, Kyrgyzstan, and other countries to promote the work of Rotary and polio eradication. In 2012 his work with Rotarians in Canada resulted in \$240m for polio eradication from the Canadian Government, which saw him receive his Honorary PHF.

d'Arcy will be speaking to us about ways to communicate around service and bring about involvement.
