

Welcome to Interact Day

What is Interact?

Interact is Rotary's service club for youth ages 12-18. Interact clubs can be community-based or school-based. Individual Rotary clubs sponsor Interact clubs and provide them with support and guidance, but each Interact club is self-governing and self-supporting. The purpose of Interact is to provide opportunity for young people to work together in a world fellowship dedicated to service and international understanding. The goals of Interact include developing leadership skills and personal integrity, demonstrating helpfulness and respect for others, understanding the value of individual responsibility and hard work, and advancing international understanding and goodwill.

Interact Clubs are required to meet at least twice a month and to carry out two service projects per year, one to help their school or local community and one to promote international understanding. Interact is one of the most significant and fastest growing Rotary Programs. Nowadays there are 17.059 Interact Clubs worldwide with 392.357 members.

Interact has also taken off rapidly in China and the RC Shanghai is proud to have already sponsored 7 Interact Clubs, namely at the following schools: Shanghai American School Pudong, Shanghai Community International School Pudong & Puxi, Nanmo, Chang Zhou Oxford International College KS3 & KS4/5, Shanghai High School International Division.


