February 23: 111 years of Rotary and World Understanding and Peace Day

23 February, 2016 is the 111st Anniversary of Rotary. On 23 February 1935, Paul Harris visited Shanghai Rotary Club to celebrate the 30th Anniversary. That was the year when Dr. Fong Foo-Sec was a RI Director and China's representative to the inaugural Council on Legislation, while Percy Chu was the Club President.

In honor of the first Rotary meeting that occurred on 23 February, 1905, Rotary International has designated February 23 annually as the "World Understanding and Peace Day" and February as "Rotary Month for Peace and Conflict Prevention/Resolution". As Rotarians, we promote international understanding and enjoy international friendships. Through Rotary programs and its Foundation, we foster personal relationships that transcend borders and form a foundation for peace.

Peace is when

- people are able to resolve their conflicts without violence and can work together to improve the quality of their
- everyone lives in safety, without fear or threat of violence, and no form of violence is tolerated in law or in practice;
- everyone is equal before the law, the systems for justice are trusted, and fair and effective laws protect people's
- everyone is able to participate in shaping political decisions and the government is accountable to the people:
- everyone has fair and equal access to the basic needs for their wellbeing such as food, clean water, shelter, education, healthcare and a decent living environment;

everyone has an equal opportunity to work and make a living, regardless of gender, ethnicity or any other aspect of identity.
