Foundation receives highest rating from Charity Navigator

For the 10th consecutive year, The Rotary Foundation has received the highest rating — four stars — from Charity Navigator, an independent evaluator of charities in the U.S. In the most recent ratings, the Foundation earned the maximum of 100 points for demonstrating both strong financial health and commitment to accountability and transparency.

In a letter to the Foundation, Charity Navigator notes that "only 1 percent of the charities we evaluate have received at least 10 consecutive 4-star evaluations, indicating that The Rotary Foundation outperforms other charities in America. This exceptional designation from Charity Navigator sets The Rotary Foundation apart from its peers and demonstrates to the public its trustworthiness."

The rating reflects Charity Navigator's assessment of how the Foundation uses donations, sustains its programs and services, and practices good governance and openness.

Back to standard meeting. We started by the Four-Way Test led by Rtn. Ling Sheng and visiting Rotarians and guests introduction by David. Rita continued the new “return back banner” by offering President Moto-san a banner from Bulgaria. During announcement time SR Frank Yih reminded that Rotary China Conference will be held in Beijing on March, 10th. He also added that early birds registration by February, 10th will enjoy 500rmb discount. Tiziana introduced our Annual Party which will be held at Marriott City Hotel on April, 7th. It will be a costume party, theme “Rotary Night at the Movies” and everyone can/has to come dressed up as his/her favorite movie character.

Another induction tonight: January really started in very prosperous way. Allan Mathieu was inducted by Terri, Chair of Membership Committee, sponsored by Rita and pinned by our President Moto-san.

Classification time tonight was really fast. Adam introduced a new way of speech, following Ignite Presentation format. 5 minutes talk for on about 20 slides. Amazing, he actually went through his life starting from 2002 when he went to Taiwan where he spent 3 years understanding he wanted to live and work in Asia, without knowing anything else. He came back home for other three years then, back to Asia again, till he landed at Maxxelli in Chongqing, leading now 50 consultants across 10 cities supporting 3 divisions.. It seems 3 is a recurring number in Adam’s life as he could finish his Classification talk in 3 minutes!

Ludovic introduced Youth Committee activities, including the Video Award Competition for Interact Club held by Rotary International. Submissions were successfully for SCIS and SHSID. He informed us that a new Interact club is on the way to be chartered: Shanghai American School Puxi. For this school 2 special positions have been arranged: IPP Andrew Hill will be the liaison Rotarian and Miss Tanya Hawkes will be the Academic Adviser. Tiziana presented the report for the PR Committee on behalf of Chair Thilo. The website is under constant update thanks to great efforts by Andrew and Candice. Some extra decision needs to be discussed within the Committee in order to improve our internal and external PR but there is margin to do it.

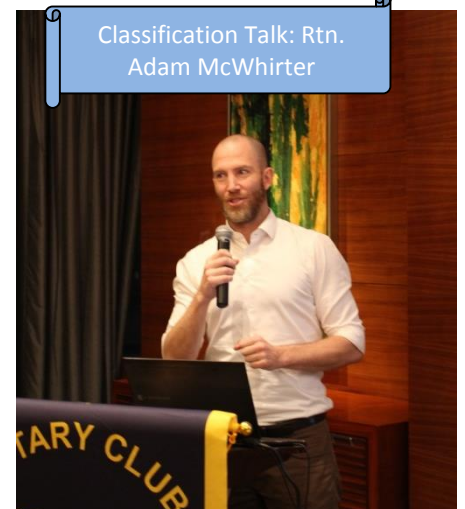
