# The Future of Work – Knut Wimburger

Knut helps executive management with organizational development challenges in a Far East Asian context and supports key individuals to unfold their potential. He believes in the healing force of purpose and is driven by giving others deeper meaning in their work.

Before he founded the Hong Kong incorporated consultancy Telos Pi, he served as managing director of Fronius China, a European headquartered technology leader in robotics welding, battery charging and photovoltaics. Earlier stations in his career include a stint as technology attaché at the Austrian Consulate General Shanghai, and two assignments in the technology law industry with a Vienna based technology transfer agency and an international law firm.

Knut holds a Masters of Law and specialized in intellectual property and technology transfer, as well as a Bachelors in Far East Asian Studies and specialized in Chinese social psychology. He is fluent in German, English and Chinese and lives since 2009 with his wife and two children in Shanghai.
