Renji Hospital in Wuhan for the Coronavirus aid

On February 19th Renji Hospital sent a team of 60 doctors, 90 nurses and six management and support staff for a total of 156 medical professional members to support newly built Leishenshan Hospital, Wuhan's second emergency hospital against the Coronavirus epidemic.

All the experienced doctors and nurses were from the intense care unit, respiratory disease and infection department and they voluntarily joined the medical team to Wuhan.



The Medical staff from Renji Hospital has been in charge of opening an intensive care unit with 31 beds and 19 respiratory machines, and a 48 beds ward.

Preparations has taken the team four days and besides the respiratory machines, facilities giving negative pressure therapy and extracorporeal membrane oxygenation (ECMO) are provided.



Dr. Zhang Jidong, vice president of Renji Hospital, said that the next step after opening the ICU will be improving the quality of medical services with the goal of raising the cure rate and cutting the death rate.

President Wei Ping Li has coordinated this action plus severe monitoring of patients within Renji hospital in order to contain the spread of the infection in Shanghai too. We should learn from this highly professional way of acting how to face in future this kind of emergency.

French Rotarians step in to help Wuhan

The birth of ICC France China dates back to 2003 with the signing of the Charter in Antibes (France) on 23 October by representatives of the two Chinese clubs at the time, Beijing and Shanghai and representatives of three French districts (D 1700,1730 and 1790) under the patronage of the then International Rotary President Jonathan Majiyagabe.



The ICC's mission

*Inter-country committees provide clubs and Rotarians with other opportunities to ensure our responsibility for world peace
The committees build bridges of friendship and cooperation with a simple and flexible structure.
They help promote Rotary's mission around the world.*

The French section of the ICC intends to act in three main areas:

Make Rotary China known in France and help its development

To facilitate the search for French clubs to participate in the implementation of Global Grants for humanitarian projects in China. Facilitate student exchanges.

In line with these goals, since its inception the ICC has participated in various Rotary actions in China and contributed to its development.

In recent years among the outstanding faiths we can quote:

A delegation of about 50 French Rotarians visited Shanghai in 2016. On this occasion, they were able to discover Rotary's work in China and meet the RC Shanghai Fresh Start and Shanghai Pudong clubs.

In 2018 and 2019, the establishment of a partnership between RC of Shanghai and RC Mayenne for the Kashin Beck Disease Prevention Project in Qinghai

This year in February 2020, following a call from RC Shanghai, the IPC launched a fundraiser to which several French clubs and districts responded, which allowed the sending of protective medical equipment to hospitals in Wuhan.

Our next project carried out by the Club of Paris East and its district is about the Franco Chinese exchange of young cardiac surgeons. It is under study in collaboration with RC Shanghai and Shanghai Elysée.

How help from Israel happened



Dear Rotarian,

We are a group of volunteers from Israel, most of us are students and some are workers. By the end of January 2020, we started to feel the situation of Coronavirus in China is getting worse and we received requests from hospitals regarding medical supplies especially masks, protective clothing. Being abroad, we felt eager to offer some help. Driving by passion, we started to raise funds from the crowd, starting mainly from students at Tel Aviv University. Meanwhile, we started to organize a small group to purchase supplies from stores all over Israel including the Palestine area. Every day, we drove around looking for high-quality masks and protective clothing and in the evening we packed them and labeled them to prepare for further transportation to China.

The result coming from these efforts are about 82K surgical masks and 150 pieces of protective clothes. All the supplies were shipped in two batches to China with the help of Hainan Airline from Tel Aviv to Beijing for free. Then our local team helped clear customs and transport with Shunfeng Express to the hospitals. They include Wuhan Union hospital, Wuhan JinYinTan Hospital, Wuhan Tongji Hospital, Wuhan First People's Hospital, Wen County People's Hospital, and HuiYang Sanhe Hospital.

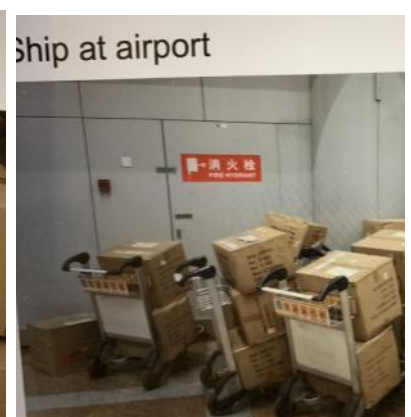
We are really grateful for everyone who participated in the mission. It's heartwarming to receive images and words from our doctors in the front line knowing we helped a bit.
