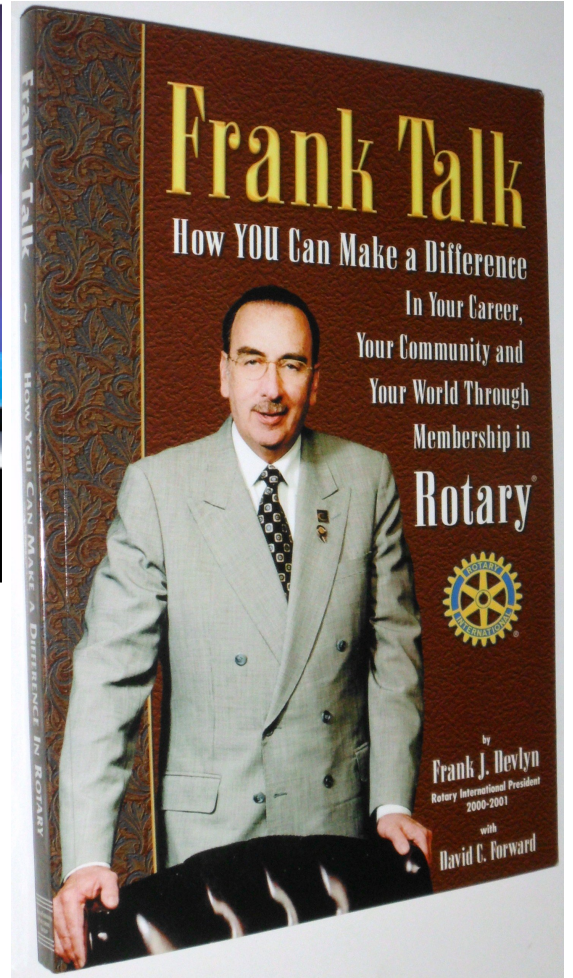

It is with deep sorrow that we inform you about the unexpected passing of Frank Devlyn on the 27<sup>th</sup> of May.



In the world of Rotary, Frank Devlyn was recognized as being one of the most sought out speakers, constantly in demand for Rotary conferences and events.

His background gave good reasons why he was considered by so many to be such a unique, successful leader. Raised on the border between Mexico and the United States, Frank proudly described himself as bicultural. "As a youngster and student, I spent time in both countries every day", he said "Home was in Juarez, Mexico, where my mother's family came from, and I went to school in El Paso, Texas. I was immersed equally in both cultures every day of my life"

Frank's father, Frank Devlyn Sr., a World War I veteran of Irish descent, came from a small town near Chicago, Illinois. Frank Sr., was an optometrist, as is Frank's mother, Nelva. After they married, they moved to Nelva's northern México hometown of Juarez, the country's largest border city, and opened a small optical shop. Frank grew up in the family business and worked in the store every day after school.

When Frank was 22 his father died. By that time, the Devlyns had opened their seventh optical shop. Frank then had to lead the family business with the help of his mother and two younger brothers. Devlyn Optical Group of which he was the C.E.O. became the largest retail optical company in Latin America.

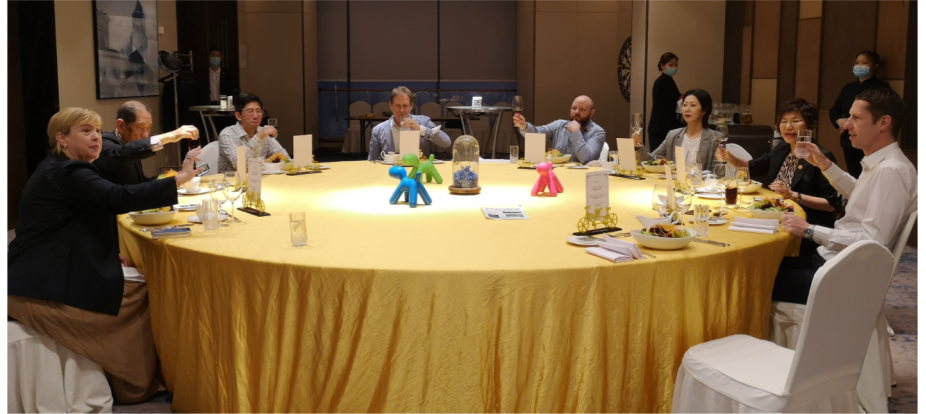
As testament to this prodigious networking ability, Frank sat on the boards of numerous national and international groups.

Frank described joining Rotary in 1970 as "a turning point in my life" and he brought to Rotary the same energy, determination and forward thinking that were hallmarks of his business career.

RI President on 2000-2001 and Rotary Foundation Chairman on 2005-2006, Frank was an impactful leader in Rotary and dedicated his life to the service, creating awareness, taking actions and leaving a lasting impression on those who met him.
