



Welcome to our visitors in Rotary From the US: Dr. Robert Detrano



Dr. Detrano is a cardiologist from the University of California, Irvine. Learning in 2005 about the lack of medical care in rural Yunnan, he founded, together with his wife, Chen Shan Shan, China Cal. Though first focused on villagers with high blood pressure and heart disease, since 2010, China Cals focus has turned toward congenital heart disease (CHD) detection in children. During the past four years, over 120,000 school children were screened and about 700 cases of heart disease detected. Of these, 350 have undergone treatment.

Unfortunately, approximately 70 poor children with untreatable heart disease were also found. It is

estimated there are between 5000 and 10000 children in this situation in Yunnan Province. Therefore it is planned to establish a school in Kunming city with a four person Directors' Committee consisting of a Public Health expert, a pediatric cardiologist, a nurse and an administrator plus a director responsible for directing the activities of the school. It will focus on these three main areas:

1. Arrange with the Department of Health for the training and supervising of rural doctors regarding the proper cardiac examination of newborns and infants.
2. Train trainers who will train local rural doctors on how to examine infants at birth and again, before the sixth month of life.
3. Assess effectiveness of the training

In July 2014 VPSC and VAFF are travelling to Guangzhou, Hong Kong and Shanghai for a Good Will Tour. The VPSC touring team will be made up predominantly of 'Veteran' age players and three female players, playing games classified as more 'social' than competitive. The VAFF team is a younger team. Heading the delegation is Assistant Commissioner (Crime) Stephen Fontana APM, the third highest ranking police member in Victoria.

The last meeting saw not only the return of many old friends and members, but also the induction of Miguel Ferrer. Welcome Miguel.

President Frank Yih gave an overview over what has been achieved in 12 years of matching grants. 29 grants had been approved, a total of 2.1mio US\$, including donations from international partners, from the Rotary Foundation and naturally from the RC of Shanghai. A truly astounding success. Some projects

mentioned were GOL (Gift of Life), the clubs signature project, focusing on congenital heart disease (briefing by Michael de Vriendt), the Wheelchair foundation, Literacy projects and general health projects. New, coming and potential projects mentioned were the Fishing Boat project (boats for victims of the Super Typhoon last year), Gift of Sight (Cataract treatment, briefing by Dr. Ada Wang from China), Gift of Smiles, a project focused on cleft palate surgery initiated by Vancouver Rotarian Magdalen Leung and Gift of Sound, focusing on hearing aids for hearing impaired children. In addition there were numerous ideas on further projects. Veronica Qin from the Huaqiao foundation gave a presentation on the Kashin-Beck disease in Tibet and the Rotary project focusing on it. Target is not only the medical treatment of the disease but also prevention by working on food diversification.

In the spirit of giving, Club Sergeant Simon Maguire and his assistant Filippo Garini did great work collecting donations for our charities. The highlight of the Club

Sergeants session was an auction of fresh cherries donated by David Smith, who had personally imported them from the US, knowing quite well that cherries are a rare treat indeed in Shanghai. Simon Tu, the winner of the bidding war, gracefully donated them to each and every table.


