There are tremendous opportunities and many challenges in peace building. Mark will provide a specific case study: Promoting Rotary initiated peace building in the Middle East.

Mark was born in Pittsburgh, PA & grew up in Southern California. Today, he is both a citizen of the USA & Israel.
