Front left seat -an airplane does not fly by itself ~ Tino Janke

One year ago Tino Janke came to Shanghai with his family. Destiny brought them to China after the bankruptcy of his former airline.

After the fall of the German wall, Tino was allowed to start flying: his childhood dream since he was a little boy!

After few years sports-flying, it became a profession. Meanwhile he earned his diploma degree in civil engineering at the University Cottbus. After the university, he started his professional flying career as a pilot. He joined Air Berlin, Germany's 2nd largest airline. At the beginning of 2002, he became First Officer on the Boeing 737. Four years later, he did his upgrade and switched as Captain to the Airbus shorthaul fleet. In 2015, he experienced another upgrade to the A330 long-haul fleet.

Until the bankruptcy of Air Berlin, he flew 10,000 hours worldwide and trained pilots for almost 1,000 hours in simulators and big and small planes.

With the bankruptcy of the airline, his family and himself got the chance to change their life and start a journey in a new world: China.

Tino is currently flying as a Captain at Juneyao Airlines. China is a huge new experience with so many impressions to him. Join us to know more about the aviation world directly from the experience of the Captain!



FOURTH The advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service
