Run in Blue is a service project organized by Rotaract Club of Shanghai since 2014. The event is a 5 km fun run to raise awareness and provide financial support to a variety of community needs. This year, proceeds from the event will go to RCS Gift of Life project, which sponsors surgery for children with congenital heart disease. Why does it matter? Every year, 150,000 children are born with congenital heart disease in China. The average amount necessary to cover a heart operation in China is 25,000 RMB. That's way above what poor families can afford.
