Raised in Southern California, resident ten years in Japan and now 22 in China, more than a decade in the private sector, since 2003 in various business school academic roles, mostly with the Antai College. Co-producer and co-host of the College's on-line program, Doing Business in China.

Research subject: titled First Time in History (FTIH) – because in terms of scope, scale and speed, China's socioeconomic rise since 1978 is unparalleled in world history. The First Time in History project investigates the history and factors that launched the rise, its evolution over the four decades since, and what's likely to come. Website and podcast coming in 2023, book (hopefully) to follow.

First book, Tales of Old Tokyo, published in 2015. Lots of papers and articles and talks since then, mostly about FTIH.

About today's Front Row Seat for the 21st Century talk:

1. The astonishing rise over the past four decades will likely continue, and propel China to global leadership in an increasing variety of sectors through the remainder of this century.
2. China is already the world leader in everything surrounding the consumer-smartphone interface, and the EV sector, and beyond that 'mobility', and along with it alternative energy . . .
3. The world isn't paying much attention to what really matters here, being distracted by . . .
